

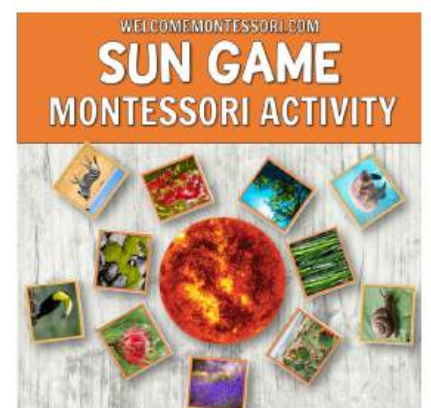
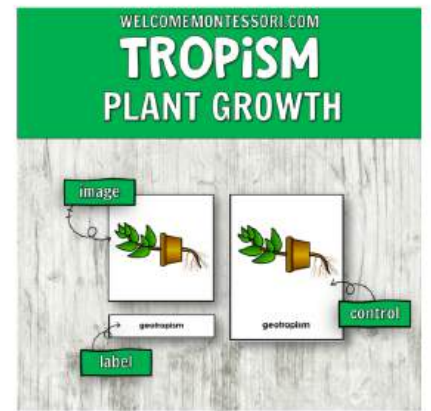

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Tide Pool Make A Model



Make a Tide Pool

Students will learn about tide pools and their importance to marine life. They will also learn how to make a model tide pool.

Instructions:

- Read the story "The Tide Pool" and discuss it with your class.
- Discuss the importance of tide pools to marine life.
- Explain to students that they will be making a model tide pool.
- Distribute the materials and let students begin their work.
- Encourage students to think about the different types of animals that live in tide pools.
- When finished, have students show their models to the class.

Materials:

- Shallow container (e.g., shoe box)
- Water
- Sand or gravel
- Small rocks
- Seashells
- Marine life figurines or toys

Directions:

- Fill the container with water.
- Add sand or gravel to the bottom.
- Place small rocks in the water.
- Add seashells to the water.
- Add marine life figurines or toys to the water.

Assessment:

Observe students as they work and ask them questions about their models. Have them explain why they chose certain items for their tide pools.
